2018 Senior Class Party Parent/Guardian Permission and Waiver

As parent or guardian, I give permission for my child or student to participate in the AHS Senior All Night Party on June 7, 2018 from the conclusion of commencement to approximately 4 a.m. on June 8, 2018. I give permission for my child/student to participate in all activities for the party including being provided District 281 bus transportation to the party venue and back to AHS at the completion of the party. I understand that students that do not take the required transportation to and from the party will not be admitted to the party and will forfeit their registration fees. I am aware of the inherent risks associated with these activities and that all risks or accidents cannot be prevented.

If emergency treatment or emergency personnel is required for my child/student, I consent to such treatment. I acknowledge that neither the 2018 Senior Party Planning Committee nor District 281 provides accident or health insurance, and I agree to be responsible for any medical costs incurred as a result of emergency medical treatment.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, I hereby hold harmless and release the 2018 Senior Party Planning Committee and ISD 281, its officers, agents, and volunteers from any claims for damages or injury to any participant from our family or our property, which may arise from any participant in the above program and all related activities.

This release and hold harmless agreement *does not apply* to intentional or negligent acts of the 2018 Senior Party Committee and ISD 281, its officers, agents and volunteers that cause harm to any participant from my family. However, by acknowledgement below with my signature, I agree that I have read and understand this hold harmless agreement and agree that the 2018 Senior Party Committee, District 281 and agents or officers of the party will not be responsible for deductibles or any insurance costs or medical costs related to my student/child participation in the party.

Student Participation and Code of Conduct Agreement

The Senior Party Committee believes that all participants of the All-Night Party have the right to a safe, respectful, and fun evening. Security and safety of this environment requires expectations, behavior guidelines and consequences should this code of conduct be violated.

Examples of misconduct that will not be tolerated include, but will not be limited to:

- Actions which present danger to the health, safety, or welfare of any person, including the offender
- Acts of sexual, religious, gender or racial harassment or violence
- Physical and verbal assault
- Evidence or probable cause of intoxication, possession, distribution, exchange or use of tobacco, narcotics, drugs or alcohol in addition to any other mood altering or chemical substances
- Leaving a District 281 sponsored function and/or a District 281 designated property hosting the 2018 All Night Senior Party

Should an incident of misconduct occur, parents or guardians will be contacted to come to the District 281 Senior Party location and retrieve their student. I/we understand that all registration monies and prizes will be forfeited without claim for refunds.

I/we understand that the party will be chaperoned by volunteers for the duration of the party, and there will be security and/or police presence to ensure the safety of my student/child and all other participants and volunteers.
